WHY SHOULD YOU BECOME A COVID-19 VACCINE PROVIDER?

- Patients trust your recommendation and your staff
- Keeps patients and family members safe (prevents severe illness, hospitalization, and death)
- Convenient for patients – COVID-19 vaccine, flu shots, and routine vaccines all in one place

HOW TO GET ENROLLED

- To initiate enrollment, go to [Instructions for Completing the Agreement Online](#) to Complete Part A and create your Provider Profile (Part B)
- Once Part A and the Provider Profile (Part B) are complete, please email covid-19.vaccine@dc.gov with scanned part A and part B signature pages to complete enrollment. Manual and digital signatures are both accepted.
- You can expect a response within 72 hours of emailing the COVID-19 mailbox regarding the status of your enrollment.



PROVIDER ENROLLMENT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How would the public know I am providing COVID-19 Vaccines?

The public will be directed to use vaccines.gov to help find providers who are offering COVID-19 vaccines. Additionally, your organization or facility can be displayed on DC's coronavirus.dc.gov/page/get-vaccinated page.

2. How long until I can order COVID-19 vaccines?

You will first need to complete a series of required trainings, including gaining access to the District of Columbia Immunization Information System Vaccine Ordering Management System (VOMS) prior to receiving your vaccine.
